AMENDED ORDER EXTENDING TIME WITHIN WHICH DEBTOR, UNITED PRODUCERS, INC. MUST ASSUME OR REJECT NON-RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY LEASES

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2005, United Producers, Inc. (“UPI”), debtor and debtor-in-possession in the above captioned case, filed its Motion for an Order Further Extending the Time Within Which the Debtor May Assume or Reject Unexpired Leases of Non-Residential Real Property (the “Motion”). Pursuant to the Motion, UPI requested an order extending to October 7, 2005 the date by which UPI must assume or reject any non-residential real property leases.

WHEREAS, UPI, in error, submitted to the Bankruptcy Court an order (the “Order”) extending the time to assume or reject non-residential real property leases until September 28,

2005. The Bankruptcy Court entered the Order on August 26, 2005.

WHEREAS, UPI now submits this amended order extending the deadline to assume or reject non-residential real property leases.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED,

1. That the time within which Debtor must assume or reject non-residential leases of real property is extended to and including October 7, 2005.

2. Pending such assumption or rejection, Debtor shall comply with its obligations and responsibilities under such leases.

3. This Order is without prejudice to Debtor's right to seek such further extension as Debtor deems necessary and appropriate.
